SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

The St Finbarr's Uniform Policy outlines the required attire for students while at school and during school-related activities. It aims to promote a sense of belonging, create a positive school identity, and enhance student safety. This policy has been developed in consultation with the school community, including students, teachers and parents.

Wearing the correct school uniform is compulsory. A message to the class teacher or school office is required when the school uniform is unable to be worn. All uniform information is reported through Compass chronicles which are communicated to families as reminders.

School Uniforms are purchased and ordered from The School Locker, in Ballina.

GIRLS

Everyday: School dress OR Navy culottes OR Navy shorts

WITH EITHER

Overblouse OR Royal Blue polo shirt with logo

Navy socks

School hat with reversible team colour

Sport: Royal Blue polo shirt with logo OR

Sports Team Coloured Shirt

WITH EITHER

Navy shorts or Navy culottes

Shoes: Black leather school shoes or Black leather joggers.

Optional: Navy fleece jacket OR Navy pullover with logo

Navy track pants / gabardine pants to be worn

WITH

Royal Blue polo shirt OR Navy wet weather jacket

Navy tights

BOYS

Everyday: Navy shorts (long-leg style, gabardine or taslon)

WITH

Royal Blue polo shirt with logo

Navy socks

School hat with reversible team colours

Shoes: Black leather school shoes or Black leather joggers

Sport: Royal Blue polo shirt OR

Sports Team Coloured Shirt WITH

Navy shorts

Black joggers (plain – no trim) and Navy socks,
school hat

Optional: Navy fleece jacket OR Navy pullover with logo

Navy track pants / gabardine pants
WITH EITHER
Royal Blue polo shirt OR Navy wet weather Jacket

JEWELLERY

Watch, one pair of studs or sleepers in their ears is permitted.
Chains and bracelets are not permitted for safety reasons.

HAIR (Including Health and Hygiene concerns)

Student's hair must be kept neat and tidy at all times. Hair at shoulder length (boys and girls) is required to be tied back. The school will provide hair ties for students when students do not have immediate access to their own. The school will discuss with families when hair is covering a student's eyes and impacting their vision.

Please label all clothing and ensure that students wear the correct school uniform at all times as per the Student Enrolment Agreement signed upon enrolment at St Finbarr's.
